- -Team sits first for meals, candidates will fill in
- -All team help with clearing tables, cleaning toilets. Coordinator does not do all the work.
- -Before each rollo from Habitual Grace and beyond, start with a song to brighten atmosphere
- -Simple rosary Saturday evening
- -Clausura simple
- -Small Teams, everyone works together
- -Weekend not for benefit of team members (adoration, stations, rosary, or prayer leads) **JOHN 3:30-35**
- -No personal palanca. If received place in exit packet for Sunday.
- -No gifts to table mates (outside Cursillo weekend only)
- -Rector to talk to all candidates outside of Rollo Room (Corridor Talks)
- -All Team Prays with Rollista before Rollo
- -Time for rollos, table discussion, corridor work, posters, and visits to the Blessed Sacrament should not be compromised
- -No Evaluation Sheets. If the team got to really know the candidates, they will know what they thought about different aspects. We are not open to suggestions or comments on how to improve the weekend. If someone doesn't like the food, the kitchen team are insulted. If someone doesn't care for so and so as a table auxiliary, don't like to sing the song, no time for themselves, too early and too late, no privacy, etc., etc. As we have learned through the years, someone will always be disagreeable.
